▪ **Good of the Order**

▪ **Treasurer's Report**

The Treasurer reported a balance of \$12,100. He reported that Lebanon NH PD recently paid dues and joined the PAC.

▪ **CALEA On-sites and Mock On-sites**

The **Vermont State Police** had a PowerDMS mock on-site for their Tier I Accreditation on July 12th. The Accreditation Team did a great job getting ready for the mock.

Durham NH PD will be having their CALEA Gold Standard CALEA On-Site April 3-6, 2017.

▪ **Old Business**

The proposed Sixth Edition of the CALEA Standards was discussed at length.

An ad-hoc review committee met at Manchester PD on August 3rd and reviewed all the proposed standards. The Chair thanked those who participated that day. The final document will be sent to CALEA in advance of the deadline for comments.

The Chair reiterated his call for NNEPAC members to review the proposed standards and post comments no later than August 19th.

▪ **New Business**

The membership was informed that Chair Murphy will be attending and representing us at the RIPAC Summit on Friday, September 23rd. The E-Board has approved his registration and overnight accommodation.

Due to the conflicts with the Veteran's Day holiday and the unusually early November CALEA Charleston conference, the Chair asked for thoughts regarding the November NNEPAC meeting. After discussion, by consensus, the group agreed to cancel the November meeting.

▪ **Training**

Paul MacMillan, Allie Jean, and Dave Holmstock discussed the various aspects of the July CALEA conference in Baltimore. As expected, the proposed Sixth Edition standards was the theme of the conference.

Paul also reported that proposed revisions to 41.2.7 Mental Health Issues have been posted on the Forum for client comments until 9/16/16. Oddly, the proposed changes are NOT the same ones proposed for the same standard in the 6th Edition.
