VSP's Helaine Gaiotti was recognized for her support of the process and NNEPAC. Helaine is retiring at the end of February. This was her last meeting. The Chair presented her with a NNEPAC pen and lead a round of applause.

Bill Wilmot reported that Claremont Police Chief Alex Scott, longtime avid supporter of NNEPAC and the Accreditation process, has announced his retirement on February 3<sup>rd</sup>. CPD's XO Capt. Mark Chase has been tabbed to lead the department.



▪ **Treasurer's Report**

Mark Collopy reported a balance of \$10,880.25. The \$1,000 sponsorship has been sent to the Rhode Island PAC for the CALEA conference. Dues continue to be received, albeit slowly. Please get your agency's dues in.
