## **BUSINESS MEETING MINUTES**

▪ **Old Business**

The Chair again pointed out that the July 2017 CALEA conference will be held in Providence, Rhode Island. The host agency is the RI State Police, but RIPAC and NEPAC will be providing support. **Bill Wilmot presented the proposed By-Law change and made the motion to accept:**

**“Section 2.**

Associate membership shall be open to any law enforcement agency outside the states of New Hampshire, Maine, Vermont, and Massachusetts: ~~or to any governmental or non-profit agency whose function effects or is affected by the accreditation process:~~ **or to any company or individual involved in law enforcement policy development or the accreditation process.”**

**Sue Lowrey seconded. By a show of hands, the By-Laws change passed unanimously. The Treasurer confirmed the presence of a quorum.**

▪ **New Business**

The next CALEA conference will be in Mobile, Alabama, March 22-25. The Vermont State Police, Newton MA PD, and Pelham NH PD will be receiving their initial Accreditation awards. Congratulations to all! The Sixth Edition of the Standards will also be released at the conference.

There was a general discussion about transgender policies. Dave Holmstock reminded the group that he has a draft policy.

Bill Wilmot pointed out that NYPD has added language to their Use of Force policy which permits officers to use deadly force to “*fire at a moving vehicle in which the officer reasonably believes the driver is attempting to carry out a vehicle-ramming attack on pedestrians.*” He suggested that agencies might want to have a discussion on the topic. He also suggested that agencies may want to look at their procedures for the management of parades in light of this new danger to citizens and first responders.

Bill Wilmot presented *Chapter 46 Compliance* as the training component.

The meeting adjourned at 12:15 PM.
